This Deed made this sixteenth day of June Eighteen hundred and unity two by us Charles Hooper and Mary Hooper his wife of Frederick County State of Maryland, witnesses that in consideration of the sum of Five dollars and the said Charles Hooper and Mary Hooper his wife do grant in fee simple unto Charles W. Johnson of the same County and State all the following described part of a tract of land situated lying and being in Frederick County State of Maryland and being part of a tract of land called Thurbine Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at a Gum Stump it being also the Beginning of Mrs Rogers lot part of same land and running thence with said lot N 83 1/2° E 18 1/2 ps thence N 81 1/2° E 8 ps to a stone near a spring thence S 3° W 2 ps to a stone N 86 1/2° W 4 ps then with the enclosing N 57° E 5 ps unto the public road then in said road S 34 1/2° E 16 1/2 ps to the 5<sup>th</sup> line of the deed from Charles Hooper and wife to Charles W. Johnson, and with the said line S 77° W 7 1/2 ps N 71° W 28 ps to the Beginning and containing one acre one rood and fifteen square perches of land more or less. It being part of the same land as that the said Charles Hooper obtained from George Blessing and wife by a deed dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 1877 and a copy of record among the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland.
