At the request of the order German Baptist Church the following Deed is received and recorded January 9th 1892 at 11th O'clock A.M.

This Deed made this 24th day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety by us Charles Hooper and Mary Ann Hooper his wife of Frederick County and State of Maryland, witnesses that in consideration of fifty dollars, we the said Charles Hooper and Mary Ann Hooper his wife do grant unto the Brothers of the Old order German Baptist Church, consisting of Daniel M. Wolf, Samuel Early, Samuel Weimann and all the Brothers of the Old order German Baptist Church of the same County and State of Maryland all the following described part of a tract of land situate lying and being in Frederick County of Maryland and being part of a tract of land called Franklin dalls Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at the end of 20th poles on the 21st line of the deed from George Shoenig to Charles Hooper and running thence according to the bearings on the 3rd day of March 1890, S 24th degrees west 11th poles to the corner of the School Ground, then with the School Ground N 85th E 10th poles thence N 3rd East 11th poles to a stone thence by a straight line S 85th W 10th poles to the beginning, containing three quarters of an acre more or less being part of the same lands that Charles Hooper obtained from George Shoenig by a deed dated January 20th 1871 and recorded in Liber P. G. No 11 folio 229 & C one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland in fee simple.
