In pursuance of the annexed order of the Court and notice given me by the solicitor for the Plaintiff in the above entitled cause, I, H. Denny Hitchman one of the regular Examiners of said Court, duly appointed, qualified and sworn, having met at the office of Edward V. Schellberg Esq., in Frederick City, Maryland, on the 7th day of December A.D. 1892 and assigned the said time and place for taking the testimony in said cause, did at the aforesaid time and place proceed to take the following testimony to wit: The Plaintiff filed with the Examiners as Evidence Exhibits Nos 1-2-3-4-5-5a-6-6a-6b-6c-7-8-8a-8b-8c-8d-8e and 9, which are herewith returned by said Examiners

James O. Hooper, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Plaintiff, being duly sworn and examined, deposes and says:

1st Q^{nt}. State your name age, residence and occupation?
Ans James O. Hooper, aged 46 years, residence Highland, this County, and am a Farmer, I am one of Complainants.

2nd Q^{nt}. Did you know Charles Hooper? Is he living or dead? what relation are you to Charles Hooper? If dead when did he die?
Ans. I know Charles Hooper, who is dead. He was my father. He died June 23rd 1892.

3rd Q^{nt}. State whether or not Charles Hooper died, seized, and possessed of any real Estate in this County, and look at Exhibits now shown you, marked, Nos 1-2-3-4-5-5a-6-6a-6b-6c, 7, 8, 8a-8b-8c-8d-8e, and state whether they describe the land of which Charles Hooper died, seized and possessed with the alienations therefrom,
Ans He did and the papers shown me describe that real Estate and the alienations therefrom.

4th Q^{nt}. Did Charles Hooper in his lifetime execute a mortgage upon any of said property? If so to whom, whether assigned to any one - for what amount? and whether still due and unpaid? Look at Exhibit No 9, now shown you, and state whether that is a copy of the mortgage and assignment,
Ans Yes he did, mortgage was made to D. E. Weinbrenner for fifteen hundred dollars, it was assigned to me, and is still due and unpaid, Exhibit No 9, now shown me is a copy of that mortgage.

5th Q^{nt}. Do you know the parties to this suit? If yes, state where they live, if any of them are infants, give their names,
Ans I know the parties, all of them live in Frederick County, except Alice V. Hesselberg who lives in Washington County, Md, all of the parties are adults except Mary Hooper.
