Item --- I give and bequeath to my son William Joseph my negro boy Dennis,

Item --- I give and bequeath to my son Woodward with my negro girl Maria,

Item --- I give, devise and bequeath all my other property real, personal and mixed to my wife Ann Susan Wintubaker during her life time after her death my land and improvements near the B. & O. Road I devise to be equally divided between my three sons William Joseph, George Washington and Woodward with. The balance of my property situated in New Market consisting of my Tavern stand in which I at present reside and my town lots together with the lot of five acres adjoining a lot of Dr. J. M. Smith described by deed of N. Pitt. Esq. I devise to be equally divided between my three daughters Ann Maria wife of Washington Burgess, Catherine Margaret, wife of Nelson Keesh and Mary Elizabeth, wife of Thomas Etchison, with this special provision --- that the portion which my fall under
