Hoonty and Emma Hoonty his wife and Albina Hoonty, all of the state of Maryland, Witnesses, that in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the said James W. Hoonty and Neturah Hoonty his wife, Levi Leichtenbeger and Emma W. Leichtenbeger his wife, Daniel J. Hoonty and Nettie Hoonty his wife, Samuel C. Hoonty and Nettie Hoonty his wife, Robert C. Hoonty and Emma Hoonty his wife and Albina Hoonty of the state of Maryland do grant unto Eliza Heptman all that Real Estate, situated in Burkittsville, Frederick County, Maryland, and described as follows, Beginning at a stone standing on the East side of the Main Street in Burkittsville at a point four perches South East from the corner of the lots belonging to the heirs of Henry and Elizabeth Dumbell and Geo. B.
