Storrell aged 34 years whose wife's name is Catharine Storrell; a son Charles Storrell whose wife's name is Annie Storrell; a son Frank Storrell; a son Frank Storrell; a daughter Mary Klipp whose husband's name is Paul Klipp; a daughter Elizabeth Hamber whose husband's name is George Hamber. all of whom are over 21 years of age except Frank Storrell and all reside in Frederick County Maryland. Except Charles Storrell and Annie his wife who reside in the State of Kansas.
