The object of the Bill filed in this cause is to procure a decree for the sale of the real estate of which Lawrence W. Wright died seized and possessed.

It alleges that Lawrence W. Wright died intestate on or about the 18th day of September, 1888, seized and possessed of certain real estate lying in Middletown District, Frederick County, Maryland, being the same real estate conveyed to the said Lawrence W. Wright by Samuel C. Peisinger by deed dated March 25th, 1866, and duly recorded in Lib. D. W. L. C. No. 3 folio 63, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

That the said Lawrence W. Wright left surviving him a widow named Emily Wright, and the following named children, viz, William F. Wright, who resides in the state of Missouri; Edward L. Wright, who is also a non resident of the state of Maryland, but whose residence is unknown, Ora Wright and Madona Wright who resides in Frederick County, and to whom the land above described descended as his heirs at law, subject to the dower right of their said mother Emily Wright, all of whom are adults, that the land above described cannot be divided without loss and injury, and the Bill prays for a sale of the property and distribution of the proceeds among the parties entitled.

It is therefore this 17th day of November, 1893, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, adjudged and ordered that the Complainants by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some news-paper published in Frederick County, once in each of four successive weeks, before the 23rd day of December 1893, give notice to the said absent defendants of the object and substance of this Bill and warn them to appear in this Court, in person or by solicitor on or before the 15th day of January 1894 to answer the premises and show cause if any they have why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
