Hanchew do grant unto Elizabeth Hanchew all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate in Frederick County Maryland in Susanna District adjoining the lands of Joshua Main, Philip Hanchew and others and being the same land which was bequeathed to the said George B. Hanchew by the last will and testament of George B. Hanchew deceased and recorded in Liber J.P.R. No 1. Folio 448 in the Register of wills Office in Frederick County Maryland as will fully appear by a reference thereto, containing about thirty acres more or less in fee simple, subject however to the payment of all the just debts of the said George B. Hanchew now due and owing.
