To the Honorable Judges of said Court.

In pursuance of an order of Court and of notice given me by the collectors for the Plaintiff, I Henry B. Worthington one of the regular and standing examiners of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity, duly appointed, qualified and sworn to, on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1894, at my law office in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, assign and fix the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April in said year, at 10 O'clock A.M. on the time, and the law office of Anna, Huey & Limer, in said City as the place for the examination of witnesses and the taking of testimony in this cause, at which last mentioned time and place, I attended, due notice having been given to the parties interested, and in the presence of the collectors for the plaintiff, proceeded to take the following depositions, that is to say:-

Bruce V. Thomas, a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff, being first duly sworn by me, and examined viva voce, deposes and saith:-

1. Int. State your name age and residence. My name is Bruce V. Thomas, my age 23 years, I reside in Frederick County.

I knew Samuel Thomas late of Frederick County deceased, he was my father, he is dead, he left no will. He died in 1879 (reigned) and possessed of a farm of 69 acres located in Backstrom District Frederick County.

I look at Exhibit A, now shown me as it correctly describes the land of which he died seized and possessed.

He left surviving him at the time of his death his widow, my mother Anna M. Thomas who died July 24 1891 and the following children and only heirs at law:

- Bruce V. Thomas, the present witness.
- George D. Thomas, an unmarried adult.
- Lottie C. Michael now the wife of Edward Michael, both of whom are adults.

Milton F. Thomas, Lottie V. Thomas Anna A. Thomas, Mary Thomas and Bennie R. Thomas, all of whom are under 21 years of age at present, all of said children are residents of Frederick County Maryland, my father, Samuel Thomas personal estate was administered by my mother Anna M. Thomas and a final act therein stated in the orphans Court for Frederick County, in which the same was entirely applied to the payment of debts, leaving a number of claims against my fathers Estate still unpaid. I have examined the claim docket in the Orphans Court and find the following are the claims yet remaining
