of partition and can not be divided among the parties interested without loss or injury and it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties interested therein that the same be sold and the proceeds arising from the sale thereof should be distributed among the parties interested therein according to their respective interests.

1st That John H. Shorb and Frederick J. Shorb have been granted letters of Administration on the personal estate of said James Shorb deceased by the orphans Court of Carroll County Maryland as will appear by an exemplified Copy of said letters herewith filed marked Complainants Exhibit "I." that said personal estate is in sufficient to pay and discharge the debts due and owing by the said James Shorb deceased and for which payment his estate personal and real is liable.

2nd That the several defendants hereinafter named, may be required to answer this bill.

3rd That the aforesaid real Estate mentioned within this bill may be deemed to be sold and after the application of the personal estate of the said James Shorb to the payment of the Claims of the Creditors of the said James Shorb in the due course of Administration shall have expended the same, the proceeds of said Real Estate shall be first applied to the payment of the balance and deficiency left unpaid and remaining due to the Creditors of said James Shorb deceased by reason of said deficiency of said personal estate to discharge the same and the remainder of said monies arising from the sale of said lands be distributed to the heirs at law of said James Shorb and persons entitled thereto and.

4th That your Complainants may have such other and a further relief as they may be entitled to and this Case require.

May it please your Honorable Court to grant unto your Complainants the writ of subpoena of the State of Maryland directed to the said James S. Shorb and Sarah A. Shorb his wife and Joshua Shorb and Elizabeth Shorb his wife residing near Steyville Carroll County Maryland and Thomas R. Waeche who resides near Rocky Ridge, Frederick County Maryland, Commanding them to be and appear in this Court at some certain day to be named therein and answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.
