E. Brown and Joseph W. Brown her husband, Harvey C. Harbaugh and
Effie Harbaugh, his wife, Clara P. Harbaugh, Jacob B. Harbaugh, Mattie
V. Harbaugh, and Samuel C. Harbaugh her husband, Mattie B. Harbaugh
respectfully represents unto your Honors:

1. That George M. Harbaugh, husband of your oratrix, Savilla Harbaugh,
late a resident of Frederick County, Maryland, died intestate on the
date March 29th 1890, leaving surviving him as his children and
only heirs at law, Upton C. Harbaugh, Mary E. Brown who is married
to Joseph W. Brown, Harvey C. Harbaugh who is married to Effie Harbaugh,
Clara P. Harbaugh, Jacob B. Harbaugh, Mattie V. Harbaugh who is married
to Samuel C. Harbaugh, Mattie B. Harbaugh, and Harry L. Harbaugh.
2. That Walter Harbaugh, a son of said George M. Harbaugh, deceased
died on the date July 11th 1889, leaving surviving him as his
children and only heirs at law, the defendants William F. Harbaugh,
Mary C. Harbaugh and Elsie Nora Harbaugh.
3. That all the parties to this cause are of age and sui juris, the
defendants Harry L. Harbaugh, son of George M. Harbaugh, deceased
and William F. Harbaugh, Mary C. Harbaugh and Elsie Nora
Harbaugh, children of Walter Harbaugh, deceased, alone excepted,
they being infants under the age of twenty one years.
4. That the said George M. Harbaugh died seized and possessed
of several tracts or parts of tracts of real Estate situated,
lying and being in Harwood District, Frederick County, Maryland,
the first consisting of one hundred and sixty three acres and
one hundred and fourteen square perches of land, more or
less, as described in the Deed from York Harbaugh and
