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At the request of George M. Harbaugh the following Deed was recorded February 24<sup>th</sup> 1873

This Deed made this 19<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Twenty two by Jost Harbaugh and Susan Harbaugh his wife of the County of Frederick and State of Maryland, witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of Four thousand ninety two Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$4092.<sup>80</sup>/<sub>100</sub>) she said Jost Harbaugh and Susan Harbaugh his wife do grant unto George M. Harbaugh of the County of Frederick and State of Maryland his heir and assigns in fee simple, all the following described parcel or tract of land lying and being situated in Frederick County and State of Maryland, being all that part of tracts called "Richards Falls" and "Bucks Range" conveyed by George Harbaugh Sr. to said Jost Harbaugh and all of a certain tract conveyed by John Harbaugh (of C) to said Jost Harbaugh said conveyance bearing date April third A.D. 1852 and also all of a certain tract of land conveyed by George Harbaugh Jr. and Julius W. Brown Trustees said conveyance bearing date November Fifteenth A.D. 1860. Beginning for the several parts to be hereby conveyed at the beginning of Deed from said George Harbaugh Sr. to said Jost Harbaugh running thence N 3/4° W 61.3 perches S 60° E 44.8 perches S 49° E 20 perches to Hickory tree S 37 1/2° E 64 perches S 6° E 52.6 perches then with and to include said Deed from John Harbaugh (of C) to Jost Harbaugh S 66° E 52.2 perches S 38° W 7.8 perches S 50° E 8 perches S 2° W 5.3 perches S 32 1/2° W 55 perches N 59 1/2° W 49 perches S 82° W 35.5 perches S 22° W 12.5 perches N 80° W 94 perches to Public Road N 40 1/2° E 34 perches N 48° E 25.6 perches N 12 1/4° E 34.8 perches.
