To the defendant the society for the protection of Children from Cruelty and immorality of Baltimore City, a Body Corporate duly incorporated the sum of Five hundred dollars.

To the defendant "The Oblate Sisters of Providence of the City of Baltimore" a Body Corporate duly incorporated, the sum of two thousand dollars.

To the defendant The Board of Managers of the Dolans Childrens Aid Society, a Body Corporate duly incorporated the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀)

To the defendant The Convent of Baltimore, a Body Corporate duly incorporated the sum of Five hundred dollars.

To the defendant the young Catholic Friends Society (Catholic Branch) a Body Corporate duly incorporated, the sum of one thousand dollars.

To the defendant "The Bureau of Catholic Indian Missions in Washington D.C." a Body Corporate duly incorporated, the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars.

To the defendant St. Vincent de Paul Orphan Asylum of the City of Baltimore, a Body Corporate duly incorporated, Called in said will St. Vincent de Paul Orphan Asylum of Baltimore City, the sum of One thousand dollars.

To the defendant the Mount Vernon Ladies Association of the union a Body Corporate duly incorporated the sum of One thousand dollars to be added to the Endowment Fund the object of which is to keep in repair the Home and last resting place of George Washington.

To the defendant "The Catholic University of America" a Body Corporate duly incorporated, Called in said will the "Roman Catholic University recently founded in or near Washington City" the sum of Five thousand dollars.

Harper letters testamentary of all and singular her personal estate were by the Orphans Court of Baltimore City, granted unto the plaintiffs Pierre C. Dugan and John Malloy, who in virtue thereof possessed themselves of all the personal estate which was of the said Emily L. Harper at the time of her death and
