This Deed made this thirty first day of December in the
year Eighteen hundred and Eighty seven by George D. Norris
Executors of the last will and Testament of William H. Warner
late of Frederick County deceased, witnesseth whereas the
said William H. Warner having sold to Adam W. Garber
of Frederick County, State of Maryland a certain parcel of land
hereinafter described & the said George D. Norris in consideration
of Two thousand & eighty seven dollars and eighty Cents the balance
due from the said Adam W. Garber do print unto the said
Adam W. Garber the following described parcel of land situate
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid being a part
of the parcel of land conveyed to said William H. Warner by
deed from Deale Buckingham dated May 24th 1865 and
recorded in Liber J. W. C. No 3, folio 204 One of the land
records of Frederick County, Beginning at a stone at the end
