Deed was recorded January 11th 1884.

This Deed made this twenty eighth day of December in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty three by us William Layman and Catharine Layman his wife Rachel Kollenburg, Michael Momingstar and Catharine Momingstar his wife, Jacob Layman & Mary Jane Layman his wife, Leonard J. Layman and Henrietta Layman his wife, Jeremiah Knode and Margaret Knode his wife, Lydia S. Layman, Susan E. Layman, George H. Layman, and Sarah Catharine Layman his wife Francis W. Wally & Barbara A. E. Wally his wife, William Baker and Sarah E. Baker his wife Solomon Baker and Susan R. Baker his wife, Lydia E. Baker and John A. Baker, witnesses, whereas a certain Henry Layman by his last will & testament duly admitted to probate & recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County did devise & bequeath unto his wife during her natural life the land & premises hereinafter specified & described and thereby directed that the same should be sold after the death of his said wife, whom he appointed the Executrix of his said last will & testament, and whereas the said wife of the said Henry Layman has departed this life, and the parties to these presents are the Children, Grand Children & devisees of said Henry Layman, who are by said last will & testament entitled to the proceeds of the sale of said land and premises in the proportions therein set forth, and whereas the parties to these presents have sold said land & premises to Christian Heep Thomas at & for the sum of forty four hundred and thirty four dollars and seventy five Cents. Now therefore in consideration of the premises & of the full payment of said sum of forty four hundred and thirty four dollars & seventy five Cents we the said William Layman and Catharine Layman his wife, Rachel Kollenburg, Michael Momingstar & Catharine Momingstar his wife, Jacob Layman and Mary Jane Layman his wife Leonard J. Layman and Henrietta Layman his wife Jeremiah Knode & Margaret Knode his wife, Lydia S. Layman Susan E. Layman George H. Layman and Sarah Catharine Layman his wife Francis W. Wally and Barbara A. E. Wally his wife, William Baker and Sarah E. Baker his wife Solomon Baker and Susan R. Baker his wife Lydia E. Baker and John A. Baker do grant unto the said Christian Heep Thomas, all that tract of land whereon the said Henry Layman resided at the time of his death, containing one hundred and five acres three rods and nineteen perches of land, the same being comprised of two pieces or parcels of land, the one called "The Hill House Lot" being the same conveyed to said Henry Layman by Otto J. Woolf & wife by deed dated the 24th day of April in the year Eighteen hundred & forty nine for six acres two rods & five perches said deed being duly
