At the request of George Layman the following Deed was recorded March 10, 1884. This Deed made this tenth day of March Eighteen hundred and Fifty four by us Christian H. Thomas and Evelina V. Thomas his wife of Frederick County, State of Maryland. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Seventeen hundred and forty four dollars and nine Cents, we the said Christian H. Thomas and Evelina V. Thomas his wife do grant in fee simple to George Layman all that part of a tract of land called "Anaby" situated in Frederick County State of Maryland, beginning for said land at a stone planted in the County road leading from the Buckystown and Urbana roads to Anaby or Gambel Mill and on the South side of the Still Home Church and running thence South fifty two degrees East One hundred and six perches and eight tenths of a perch to a stone planted at the end of the 5th line of the whole tract called Anaby, then North fifty three degrees East Seventy perches North fifty two degrees West One hundred and twenty one and a half perches to the abutment named County road, then with said road South thirty seven degrees West fifty eight perches and two tenths of a perch, to the place of beginning containing forty nine acres three rods and thirteen perches of land more or less.
