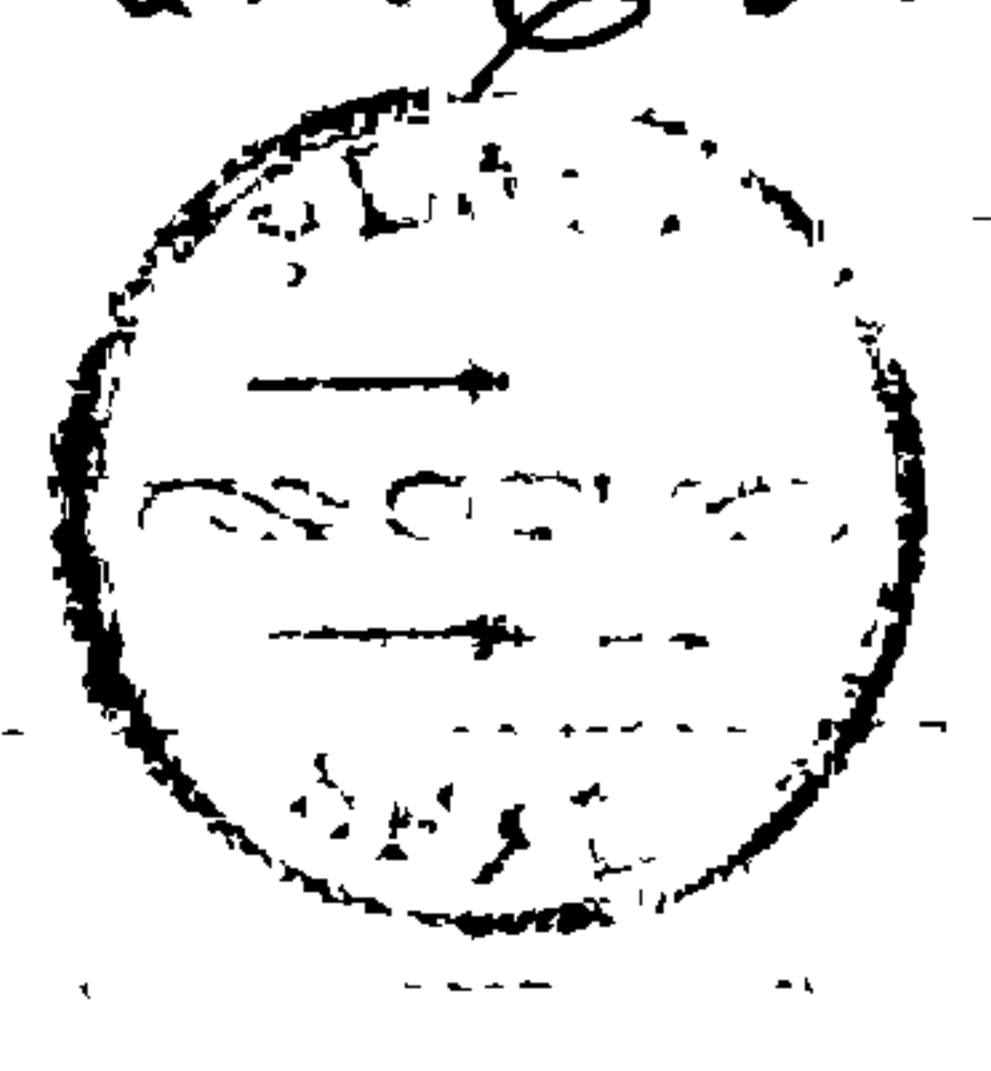

At the request of Frederick White the following Deed is received for Record and Record on August 30 - 1879, at 11 O'clock 50 minutes A.M.

This Deed made this sixth day of July in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty one by Minerva A. Draper of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars the said Minerva A. Draper doth grant unto Frederick White all that tract or parcel of land known as the "Three Hill Seals" Situate and lying in Harwood District in the County of Frederick on the County road running from Mechanistown Frederick County to Courtown Washington County about one half mile east of Popville in Frederick County and adjoining the lands of Jonathan Brown Johnson and others being the same property formerly owned on the Tax Books of Frederick County to Wolfbergers heirs and sold for Taxes by Arthur Del Schmitt Tax Collector for Frederick County and by him conveyed to Isaac Draper by deed dated November A.D. 1868 and also conveyed in a Deed from Isaac Draper to Minerva A. Draper bearing date April 3rd A.D. 1879 and recorded in Liber W.D. No. 11 folio 320 one of the Land records of Frederick County containing sixty acres of Land more or less in fee simple.
