5th A tract of Mountain Land described in a deed from Dr Harvey Buchanan and wife recorded in Liber W.D.P. No. 13 folio 61 & 62 one of the Land Records of Frederick County containing 33 acres and 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ perches more or less being part of Poplar Grove situated about 4 miles from Summit and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles S. E. of Popville adjoining the lands of Mr. McAfee and the trustees of some willow. The timber is mostly young Chestnut and Oak.

6th A tract of Mountain Land, described in a deed from Minnie Doper recorded in Liber W.D.P. No. 4 folio 487 & 88, one of the Land Records of Frederick County known as "Three Mill. Tract" containing 60 acres more or less situated about 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles E. of Popville on the road leading from Summit to Cawtown, adjoining the lands of Stephen Brown, John H. Rice, dec'd and others. This lot is finely set in good large timber and is a very desirable lot.

7th A tract of Mountain Land described as Lot No. 3 in a deed from Wm White and Wm J. Black trustees and Jacob Buffington recorded in Liber W.D.P.
