- 1st That in the year 1850 Joel Hull and Mary Hull, his wife conveyed to Mary Jacobs, Daniel Jacobs, Adam Jacobs, Susannah Jacobs and Margaret Jacobs certain real Estate situated in Frederick County, Maryland, a Certified Copy of which deed as recorded in the Land Records of Frederick County is filed herewith marked Exhibit No 1 to this Bill, which Exhibit with such other Exhibits as the plaintiff may file hereto he prays may be considered as a part hereof,
- 2nd That in the year 1858 David Jacobs, Christina Boyer, Catherine Coval & Jonathan Coval, her husband, Elizabeth Boyer, and Michael Boyer, her husband who were brothers and sisters, and as such, heirs at law of the said Mary Jacobs, who died intestate, conveyed by deed their interest as heirs at law of the said Mary Jacobs in and to the real Estate described in Exhibit No 1 to the said Daniel Jacobs, Adam Jacobs, Susannah Jacobs and Margaret Jacobs as will appear by reference to a Certified Copy of said deed filed hereto marked Exhibit No 2.
