At the request of Adam L. Jacobs the following Deed is recorded July 4th 1881.

This Deed makes this Fourth day of January in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty one by us Adam Jacobs, Hermann Jacobs, Margaret Jacobs of Frederick County Maryland and Jonathan Jacobs and Mary M. Jacobs his wife of Montgomery County Maryland of the first part and Adam L. Jacobs of Frederick County Maryland of the second part.

Witnesseth that in Consideration of one thousand five hundred and Seventy dollars the said parties of the first part do grant to the party of the second part the following described parcel of land lying in Mount Pleasant District Frederick County Maryland being part of a tract of land called Middle Plantation and included within the following lines. Beginning at the end of the west fifty two perches line of a deed from Joel Hull & wife to the parties of the first part and running with part of the first line North 61 1/2° West 45 7/10 perches to a stone now planted then leaving the outlines south 27° West 149 7/10 perches to intersect the fifth line of said Conveyance then with the outlines of said deed south 88 1/2° East 68 perches to a stone south 2° East 10 perches to a stone South 88 1/2° East 57 7/10 perches to a stone North 13° East 135 perches to a stone thence west fifty two perches to the beginning containing ninety five acres and Eighteen square perches of land more or less; it being part of the same land conveyed to the parties of the first part by Joel Hull and wife by deed dated February 26th A.D. 1850 and recorded in Liber W.B.S. No. 11 Folio 141 & one of the land Records of Frederick County reference thereto here will more fully appear, and the said parties of the first part Covenant that they will warrant generally the property hereby
