

No. 6427. Equity.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County.
The Report of Roscoe C. White trustee, appointed by a Decree of this Court, passed in the above entitled Cause, dated the 12th day of August A.D. 1895 to make sale of Certain real Estate therein above mentioned respectfully shows.
