at her death. I devise and bequeath that the net annual income to which my daughter shall be entitled at her death, together with such portion of my wife's income as shall be given to such issue under the fifth foregoing Clause shall for the period of twenty years after my daughter's death, be divided among her said issue, if they shall live so long, to be divided among such issue, if more than one, equally per Stirpes. But this provision in favor of the issue of my said daughter is subject to the powers reserved to my wife and daughter of devising their said net income for said period as hereinafter provided.

Seventh. But if my said daughter shall die leaving issue living at her death, I devise and bequeath that the net annual income to which my daughter shall be entitled at her death, together with such portion of my wife's income as shall be given to such issue under the fifth foregoing Clause, shall for the period of twenty years after my daughter's death, be divided among her said issue, if they shall live so long, to be divided among such issue, if more than one, equally per Stirpes. But this provision in favor of the issue of my said daughter is subject to the powers reserved to my wife and daughter of devising their said net income for said period as hereinafter provided.

Eighth. If my daughter should die after my wife, but leaving issue at her death, and within said period of twenty years, the said issue of my daughter shall all be dead, then upon the death of all such issue, I will and provide that until said twenty years shall elapse, the entire net annual income given to the issue of my daughter under the foregoing provision, shall go to and be distributed among my brother and sister and the descendants of a deceased brother or sister equally per Stirpes, but subject to powers of devising portions thereof reserved to my wife and daughter respectively as hereinafter provided.

Ninth. In case upon the death of my daughter, she shall leave issue living, I hereby authorize and empower her by will or any instrument in the nature thereof, to divide the income to which she may be entitled at her death, among such issue, to such of them, in such manner and in such proportions as she shall think fit; such income to be enjoyed by such issue in such manner and proportions as she shall prescribe for the period of twenty years from her death, if such issue, or any of them shall so long live, and I also authorize and empower my said daughter by will or other instrument as aforesaid, to prescribe the manner and proportions in which such issue or any of them shall hold and enjoy the principal from which such income shall be derived, in case any of such issue shall survive to the period of twenty years after her death, and I hereby direct my said daughter and their successors in the trust, to pay over, deliver, and convey such trust, property or principal then in their hands, in accordance
