The foregoing petition, having been read and considered, it is thereupon this 11<sup>th</sup> day of April, in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety six, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the Authority thereof, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the report of sales filed in the above entitled cause by William B. Kramer, Arthur Cromwell and Samuel H. Saundee, Trustees therein named, on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January, 1876, reporting the sale of the farm containing One hundred and ninety two acres, part of the same to Melville Cromwell, he and the same is hereby finally ratified and confirmed. Nunc pro tunc, as of the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1876, no cause to the contrary having been shown, although due notice was given as appears from the printed Certificate filed in this cause, and recorded among the proceedings therein.
