whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, passed March 29th 1879, Mary C. Koontz was divorced from her husband, Edward P. Koontz, and awarded the sum of three (3) dollars per week permanent alimony, and whereas in pursuance of said decree and alimony so allowed and being in arrears from the date of said decree, the said Court, in a proper proceeding before it, after a full hearing, did on the 1st day of May 1879, decree that the said Edward P. Koontz was in default and owed to the said Mary C. Koontz the sum of \$1572.00, and passed an order requiring the said Edward P. Koontz to pay said sum of money on or before the first day of June, 1879. Now this instrument of writing witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of twenty one thousand dollars now paid to the said Mary C. Koontz, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Mary C. Koontz, in order to finally settle all claims for alimony now due on that day hereafter become due, in consideration of the aforesaid sum of money doth hereby and forever release and discharge the said Edward P. Koontz, his heirs, assigns and personal representatives of and from all alimony that may now be due or any alimony that at any time hereafter ought to be due, and therefore now and forever release the said Edward P. Koontz, and forever discharge and acquit him from the payment of all and any alimony, past, present or future, of every kind and nature whatsoever.
