At the request of James O. Palmer the following Deed was recorded August 14th, 1860.

This Deed made this 27th day of February in the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty by Jacob Rontzahn of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland Witnesseth, that in consideration of Thirty dollars the said Jacob Rontzahn doth grant unto James O. Palmer of the said County and State all that lot of ground situated in Frederick County, which is described as follows, Being part of a tract of land called "Shady Grove", being all that part of the 33 acres deeded by Isaac Mealy to said Jacob Rontzahn, which lies west of Catotie Creek and between said James O. Palmer's lot bought of Jacob Summers of C. and the eight line of the deed of Jacob Leatherman from George Wainman Executor of John Wainman deceased, containing three quarters of an acre of land more or less in fee simple.
