This Deed made this eleventh day January A. D. 1889, by William B. Morrison, & Penina his wife of the County of Frederick, State of Maryland, Witnesses, that in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars, the said William B. Morrison & Penina his wife have bargained & sold to William Morrison of the County & State aforesaid, all those tracts or parcels of land designated by certain antiquated names, lying & being in the 5th Election District, County & State aforesaid, being part of three tracts or parcels of land conveyed by Washington Senesey, Trustee, to a certain William Smith by deed dated 10th day of August A. D. 1863 & recorded in Liber B. G. F. No. 6 folio 186, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, reference thereto being made will more fully & large appear.

Beginning for said parts or parcels of land at a stone near & on the South side of the Public road leading from Maxell's Mill to the old Baltimore road & running thence with an allowance of two degrees variation to correspond with the metes & bounds heretofore given, South 26 3/4 degrees West 76.2 perches to a gate, thence South 74 degrees East 61 perches to a stone, thence South 5 degrees East 39.4 perches, thence North 76 degrees East 24.7 perches, South 1/2 degrees East 142 perches to a stone, thence North 89 degrees, East 26.6 perches to a stone, thence North 31 degrees East 22 perches to a stone now planted, thence North 34 1/4 degrees,
