Supplemental

bill of complaint that the said Samuel E. Grose, deceased, did, seized and possessed of a certain other small lot or parcel of land situated in Frederick County, Maryland, containing three acres of land more or less, and being the same lot or parcel of land which the said deceased obtained in his life time from Samuel H. Shipley by deed dated the 21st day of February A. D. 1879 and recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County aforesaid which deed is herewith filed, marked Exhibit No. 1 and prayed to be taken and considered as fact hereof.

Third; That the proceeds of sale of the real estate of said deceased already sold by said Trustees is not sufficient to pay all the debts of said deceased as appears by said proceedings and certificate of the Register of Wills of Carroll County herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 2.

Fourth; That a certain William H. Pearce of Frederick County, Maryland, and James H. Pearce of Howard County, Maryland, Executors of James Pearce obtained a judgment on the 11th day of December A. D. 1892, in the Circuit Court for Frederick County against the said Samuel E. Grose now deceased for the sum of four hundred and thirty eight dollars and seven cents (\$438.07) with interest from date and costs of suit as appears by a certified copy of said judgment herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 3, which judgment appears of Record and still outstanding and unpaid.

Fifth; That a certain Abalom Anderson, Ernest M. Anderson and Thomas M. Anderson partners trading etc as Anderson & Co. obtained a judgment on the 1st day of August A. D. 1890, in the Circuit Court for Carroll County, against the said Samuel E. Grose and Ruth Grose for the sum of three hundred and two dollars and forty five cents (\$302.45) with interest from date and \$7.00 cost which judgment was on the 2nd day of October A. D. 1890, recorded in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, and was also on the 28th day of April A. D. 1892, entered to the use of Albert Jones, as appears by a certified copy of said judgment herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 4 which judgment, appears of record in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as still outstanding and unpaid.

Sixth; That the said Ruth Grose departed this life in Carroll County, about the day of December A. D. 1891.

Seventh; That a certain Albert Jones, of Carroll County, Maryland, on the 1st day of October A. D. 1890, obtained a judgment in the Circuit Court for Carroll County against the said Samuel E. Grose now deceased and Ruth Grose now deceased, for the sum of two hundred and seventy nine Dollars and sixty five cents (\$279.65) with interest from date and \$7.00 costs, which judgment was on the 2nd day of October A. D. 1890, duly recorded in the Circuit Court for Frederick County and was on the 28th day of April A. D. 1892, entered to the use of Albert Jones, Executor of Ruth Grose, deceased as appears by a certified copy of said judgment herewith marked Exhibit No. 5, which judgment appears of Record in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as still outstanding and unpaid.

Eighth; That it would be to the interest of the creditors of said deceased, and all persons interested in said lot or parcel of land herein mentioned that the same be sold at private sale.

Ninth; That the said Mary Grose, George Grose, Jesse Grose, and John H. Grose are still infants under age of twenty one years, and reside in Carroll County, Maryland.
