Grove, infants under the age of twenty one years of Carroll County, Maryland, commanding them and each of them and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises, and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein, And as in duty bound &c.

of the sum of thirty five dollars, I the said Samuel W. Shipley do grant unto Samuel
E. Grove of Carroll County in the State aforesaid all that part of a tract of land
called "Shirley's Integrity" or whatever the same may be called containing about three
acres of land more or less, it being all that part of the land which lies in
Frederick County, which was heretofore conveyed to Nimrod Harrison by deed
from James H. Peare Trustee and recorded among the Land Records of Carroll
County, aforesaid, it being also the same land and premises heretofore
