Bill of Complaint

whose husbands name is F. B. Burke, which sister has a half interest in the proceeds of the property described in Exhibit No. 1, after the payment of a certain claim of the said George H. Harman against said property which will appear by reference to said deed, exhibit, No. 1, who reside in Baltimore City,

5th That the said George H. Harman left surviving him the following named parties as his heirs at law in whom said property vested as tenants in common, upon his death to wit: A widow Lenah R. Harman, a resident of Baltimore City,

An adult married daughter, Minnie Anderson, whose husbands name is Richard Anderson, residing in Baltimore City,

An adult son William Harman whose wife name is Amelia Harman and who reside in Baltimore City,

An adult son Charles Harman whose wife name is Laura Harman residing in Frederick City,

An adult daughter Mollie Harman, residing in Philadelphia and a non-resident of the State of Maryland,

An adult son Frank Harman a resident of Baltimore City,

An adult daughter Bessie Harman, a resident of Balto. City,

An infant son Robert Harman a resident of Baltimore City, Maryland,

An infant daughter Clara Harman, resident of Balto. City, Md.

An infant daughter Virgie Harman residing in Balto. City, Md.

6. That the entire interest of the said George H. Harman upon his death descended to and vested in the widow Lenah R. Sappington and the aforementioned children his heirs at law as tenants in common.

To the end therefore:—

1. That an account may be taken under the direction of your Honorable Court of the said debts so as aforesaid due to your complainant and of all other debts which were owing by said intestate, at the time of his death and which still remain due and unpaid,

2. That said real estate of the said George H. Harman, deceased or so much thereof as may be necessary may be sold and the proceeds applied to the payment of the debts due and owing by said Harman to your complainants, as well as such other debts as he may have had,

3. That if the proceeds from the sale of said real estate exceed the amount of the claim or interest of said George Harman in and to said property as provided by said deed Exhibit No. 1, the residue be distributed to the said Catharine Burke and the creditors of the said George Harman according to their respective rights and interests.

4. And for such other and further relief as the nature of complainants case may require,

May it please your Honors to grant unto your complainant the writ of Subpoena directed to the said Catharine Burke, F. B. Burke, her husband, Minnie Anderson, Richard Anderson, William Harman, Amelia Harman, Charles Harman, Laura Harman, Frank Harman, adults, residents of the State of Maryland, and Clara Harman, Virgie Harman, and Robert Harman, infants resident of the State of Maryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court, in person or by Attorney and show cause if any they may have why a
