This deed made this 14th day of April in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and sixty six by George Geesey of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that for the consideration of the sum of two thousand and five hundred dollars in hand paid the said George Geesey does hereby grant in fee simple unto John John J. Geesey of Frederick County, in the State aforesaid all of his right, title interest and claim of in and to the following part or parcel of a tract of land called "Force Put" Originally called "Miller's Lohamel" containing one hundred and fifty eight acres and thirty perches of land more or less, being the same land which was conveyed to the said George Geesey by Henry Ramsburg, Trustee by deed bearing date October the 21st A. D. 1848 and recorded in Liber N. B. T. No. 8 folio 570 and 571 one of the Land records of Frederick County, as by reference thereto will more fully and at large appear. And also the following part or parcel of a tract of land called the "resurvey on Long Range" being Lot No. 3 folio of said tract containing fourteen acres of land more or less in fee simple.
