This deed made this twenty fifth day of October in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four by Jacob H. Keiser, Trustee, of Frederick County, Maryland, Witness, whereas the said Jacob H. Keiser was on the 13th day of October A.D. 1884 appointed trustee in case No. 5008 in the Court of Equity of said County and authorized to sell the land decreed to be sold and has sold the same to John J. Geesey for the sum of Thirteen hundred and fifty dollars who has fully paid the purchase money therefore. Now therefore, Witness that in consideration of the premises, the said Jacob H. Keiser, Trustee, doth grant unto the said John J. Geesey, all the right, title of all the parties to the aforesaid cause in and to all that lot or parcel of land lying in Lewistown in Frederick County, Maryland, being part of Lot No. 9 according to the plat or plan of said Town containing sixty feet more or less on Frederick Street one hundred and twenty feet more or less in depth in fee simple. Also the possession right and interest in part of lot No. 8 of said Town, running sixty feet more or less on Federal Street and hundred and twenty feet more or less in depth, it being the same lots or parcels of land which was conveyed by deed of Peter Walton to William A. Walton, dated May 30th A.D. 1881, and recorded in Liber A. F. No. 7 Folio 2 one of the land records of Frederick County, and more recently by deed of the said William A. Walton and wife to Augustus M. Geesey dated April 3rd A.D. 1883, and recorded in Liber No. 7 Folio 120 one of the land records of Frederick County.
