Amelia M. Geesey, Franklin K. Geesey, et al.

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:-

The joint and several answers of Franklin K. Geesey and Grace Geesey his wife, Alva S. Rein and Victor B. S. Rein, her husband, defendants in this cause to the Bill of Complaint of Charles E. Geesey against them and others, answering say, 1st

That they admit that John T. Geesey late of Frederick County, died intestate, and indebted to the Frederick Town Savings Institution, upon a mortgage note, and to divers other persons and that he left surviving him a widow and heirs at law; but they deny that the personal property of said John T. Geesey is insufficient to pay his debts, as charged in said Bill of Complaint.

2nd. That they aver that one George Geesey, a brother, who also died intestate, at said Frederick County, on the 21st day of October 1879, left a large personal estate, valued at about \$3400 - one third of which sum, less cost of administration, will accrue to the estate of John T. Geesey, which estate of said George is now being administered upon in the Orphans Court for said Frederick County, by Augustus M. Geesey Administrator who by petition has come in as co. plaintiff in this cause a certified copy of the return of said Administrator is herewith filed as part hereof and marked Exhibit A. M. G.

3rd. They admit that said John T. Geesey was indebted to said George Geesey in the sum of \$1554.81 as charged in said of said Administrator, but they aver that one third of said sum of \$1554.81 (namely \$518.27 less costs of Administration) will accrue to the estate of said John T. Geesey, which taken together, with
