This Mortgage made this seventh day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety two by us Harry P. Gallagher and Gertrude B. Gallagher his wife both of Baltimore City, State of Maryland, Witnesses, Whereas, Harry P. Gallagher by his promissory note of even date herewith payable three years after date to Arthur Potts or order in the sum of Ninethundred dollars with interest from date at the rate of five per cent per annum payable semiannually stand indebted unto the said Arthur Potts in the sum of money in said promissory note recited and for the purpose of securing the payment of the same and all interest that may accrue thereon, when the same shall become due and payable by the terms of said promissory note as the said Harry P. Gallagher and Gertrude B. Gallagher his wife have agreed to execute these presents, Now therefore in consideration of the above recited promises and the sum of One dollar in hand paid at and before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt is hereby accepted and acknowledged by the said Harry P. Gallagher and Gertrude B. Gallagher his wife do hereby grant unto the said Arthur Potts all that part of tract of land called "Richards" lying on the Monocacy River in Frederick County, State of Maryland, and also all that other part of a tract of land called "Richlands" it being part of a tract of land called Addison's Choice, situated in the County and State aforesaid containing in the aggregate three hundred and fifty-two acres, One rood and Twenty six square perches of land and being the same land, heretofore conveyed to Joseph Baughen and Alexis O. Baughen as tenants in common by Catherine A. Norman, Executrix of John Norman by deed dated on the 20th day of March A. D. 1860, and recorded in Liber B. G. F. No. 5 Folios 330 &c. one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and being the same farm devised to the said Harry P. Gallagher by the last will and testament of his Grandfather Joseph Baughen deceased bearing date on the Twenty fifth day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and twenty six and
