Bill of Complaint.

Children, all of whom are infants, as heirs at law: - William A. Norwood, Mamie Norwood, Herman Norwood, George G. Norwood and John E. Norwood, Jr. and the said Nettie Bartrell, another of said devisees in remainder, is now the wife of Charles J. Barnum.

6. That by virtue of said devise the said real estate is vested in your Orators and Oratrices, Alfred J. Bartrell, Singleton K. Bartrell, Jesse J. Bartrell, Ellen Purdum and Nettie L. Barnum and the said children and heirs at law of the said Clementine Norwood, deceased, as tenants in common, the undivided interest of the said children of Clementine Norwood being subject to the marital rights of their father the said John E. Norwood and the said real estate is situated in Frederick County, Maryland.

7. That the said infant Defendants are all residents of Baltimore City, in the State of Maryland.

8. Norwood, Jr. infant Defendants, residing with their said father, John E. Norwood, at 2568 Druid Hill Avenue in Baltimore City, Maryland, commanding them each of them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be named in said writ to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be herein passed.
