This Deed this 10th day of August in the year Eighteen Hundred and
 Ninety seven, by William H. Winbrenner and Emma B. Winbrenner his wife of
 Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, of the one part and Maggie A.
 S. Routzahn and John H. Routzahn her husband of the same State and County
 aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth: - that for and in consideration of
 house stable and all the buildings thereon and 3 parcels of land sit-
 uated and lying in the west end of the Village of Graceham
 in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, said property adjoining the prop-
 erty of Wm. L. Armacost and Van B. Osler as follows, first the said house
 stable and all buildings thereto belonging which said property was con-
 veyed to Maggie A. S. Routzahn by deed bearing date the 26th day of
 January 1888 by Jacob A. Bernard acting Executor of Julia Biggs late of
