In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a County,

The Object of this suit is to procure a decree for the sale of certain Real Estate
situated in Frederick County in the State of Maryland, which was mortgaged by the
defendants, Hiram Harbaugh, to the Fredericktown Savings Institution, a body corporate
and which mortgage has been assigned to the Plaintiff, Charles Rohrbach.

The bill states, that on or about the twenty-fourth day of July A.D. 1881 and the said
Hiram Harbaugh conveyed certain real estate, which is particularly described
in said bill unto said Savings Institution by way of mortgage to secure the payment
of the sum of three thousand dollars which was then due and owing by the said
Hiram Harbaugh to said Savings Institution and for which the said Harbaugh
gave his promissory note of even date payable six months after date to said
Fredericktown Savings Institution or order, that said note was regularly renewed
by said Hiram Harbaugh until the date July 21st 1894, the date of which
the last renewal thereof, and that a portion of said real estate conveyed by said
mortgage was released from the operation thereof and that on the 16th day of August
A.D. 1895 the said Fredericktown Savings Institution assigned said deed of mortgage
and said note as last renewed to the Plaintiff, Charles Rohrbach.

That the whole of said sum of three thousand dollars with interest thereon from the
twenty-fourth day of January A.D. 1895 still remains due and owing to Plaintiff.
That since the execution of said mortgage the execution of said mortgage the real
estate therein described and conveyed has become encumbered by the following liens:
namely, By a mortgage for nine hundred dollars which has been duly assigned
to William P. Maulsby and Jacob Rohrbach.
