

Commission re,

No. 6940 Equity.

And to the end that the said Court may be enabled to make a just assignment to said Plaintiff Olivia G. Remsburg of her Dower in the aforesaid lands and tenements it was ordered by said Court that a commission issue to you the said Josiah Durb Daniel Miller, D. Samuel Hooge, George W. Coor and John S. Lakin authorizing you or any four or three of you, to go upon, walk over, survey, lay off and designate the one third part of the said premises as and for the dower of said Plaintiff Olivia G. Remsburg in the same -

The said premises being as follows, to-wit:-

- (1) All that tract or parcel of land situate in Frederick County, described and conveyed in the deed George W. Remsburg, Trustee of Hanson Remsburg Remsburg to John W. Remsburg and Asa G. Remsburg as tenants in common by deed dated July 31, 1867 and Recorded in Liber G. W. No. 4 folio 60 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, a certified copy of which is filed in said cause No. 6940 Equity as Exhibit No. 3.
- (2) Certain tracts or parts of tracts or parcels of land lying in Frederick County, Maryland, described and conveyed in the deed from Asa G. Remsburg and Eliza Remsburg his wife to John W. Remsburg dated April 7th 1883 a certified copy of which is Recorded in Liber A. F. No. 7 folio 247 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and filed in said cause No. 6940 Equity as Exhibit No. 4. The said two deeds said to embrace two tracts or parcels of land one containing one hundred and twenty four and three quarters (124 3/4) acres of land and the other containing Eight (8) acres and Eighteen (18) perches of land.
- (3) All that parcel of land lying in Frederick County, conveyed and described in the deed from John Feaster, Sr. and Elizabeth Feaster, his wife, to John W. Remsburg, dated April 1st 1862, and recorded in Liber B. G. F. No. 7 folio 427 one of the Land Records of Frederick County and containing one hundred and seventy seven and a half acres and six perches (177 1/2 acres + 6 perches) of land. A certified copy of which is filed in said cause No. 6940 Equity as Exhibit No. 5.
- (4) All those several pieces portions or lots of grounds, tenements and hereditaments situated lying and being in "Keller's Addition to Middletown" in Frederick County, aforesaid conveyed and described in the deed from William H. Miller and Susan L. Miller, his wife, to John W. Remsburg dated March 17th 1882, and Recorded in Liber A. F. No. 5 folio 270 one of the Land Records of Frederick County a certified copy of which is filed in said cause No. 6940 Equity as Exhibit No. 6.
- (5) All that part of a tract of land lying and being in Frederick County conveyed and described in the deed from Charles T. S. Levy, Trustee to John W. Remsburg dated June 12th 1873 and Recorded in Liber J. J. No. 5 folio 130 one of the Land Records of Frederick County and containing three (3) Acres three (3) rods and thirty six (36) square perches of land more or less, a certified copy of which is filed in said cause No. 6940 Equity as Exhibit No. 9. Therefore you or any four or three of you are, hereby fully authorized and empowered to enter upon walkover survey locate and lay off one third part of the real estate aforesaid in the proceedings in said cause mentioned as aforesaid as and for the dower of the said Olivia G. Remsburg, as aforesaid in the aforesaid Real Estate

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
