The subscribers, Commissioners, appointed by a Commission issued out of this Court in a cause wherein Olivia C. Ramberg is Plaintiff and John C. Motter Executor of the last will of John W. Ramberg, deceased, and others are defendants and which commission is herunto annexed, do hereby certify that after having taken the oath annexed unto said Commission for us to be taken, and given notice to the parties of the time and place of our meeting, we did, in pursuance of said notice, meet on the land mentioned in said Commission, and did ride, walk over and examine and have caused said real estate to be surveyed and laid out.
