The bill then prays that a decree may be passed for the said of said real estate and disposition of the proceeds among the parties in the after reimbursement of said Ellen John and William Lutz for the amounts expended by them in the improvement of said real estate and payment of taxes and insurance and for general relief, and also prays for proceeds against the resident defendants and an order of publication against the said non-resident defendants.

It is thereupon this 14th day of June A.D. 1899, ordered by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity that the plaintiff by causing a copy of this order of publication to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County, once a week for four successive weeks, prior to the 14th day of July A.D. 1899, give notice to the aforesaid non-resident defendants of the object and substance of the bill warning them and each of them to be and appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 31st day of July A.D. 1899 to show cause if any they have, why a decree ought to be passed as prayed.
