5th And further answering as to the matters and things stated and alleged in the seventh paragraph of said Bill of Complaint these respondents say they neither admit nor deny because they do not know that said Plaintiff accumulated a considerable sum of money at laundry and other work and as to such allegation they leave the plaintiff to her proof and answering further these respondents say they neither admit nor deny because they do not know that said Plaintiff accumulated a considerable sum of money at laundry and other work - and these respondents neither admit nor deny that there was a new building erected upon said property costing nine hundred and sixty dollars as to which allegation these respondents demand full proof, and these respondents deny that said plaintiff contributed out of her alleged earnings the sum of four hundred and sixty dollars or any part thereof and the said William Lutz the sum of two hundred dollars or any part thereof to the building of said house if the same was built and these respondents insist and charge if a new house was built on said lot of ground at a cost of nine hundred and sixty dollars or any part thereof the money to build the same was wholly furnished and paid by the said Catherine Lutz and these respondents further aver and say that even if said Ellen Lutz and William Lutz furnished any money whatever used in the erection of said house, they did not furnish the same with the same knowledge and consent of these respondents but voluntarily for their own uses and purposes and with a proper care,
