I give and bequeath to my nephew Maurien G. Main son of my brother Jonathan C. Main, the sum of five hundred dollars

I give and bequeath to my niece, Mrs. Cora E. R. Holter daughter of my brother Jonathan C. Main the sum of five hundred dollars.

I give and bequeath to my niece Sarah E. Fleming daughter of my deceased daughter Daniel A. Main the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars.

In case of the death of my niece, Sarah E. Fleming, I give and bequeath to her child or children, living, the said sum of four hundred and fifty dollars, should she, (my niece, Sarah E. Fleming) die without leaving any children or child, then I give and bequeath the said sum of four hundred and fifty dollars to my brother Jonathan C. Main.
