This Deed made this 24th day of March in the year Eighteen Hundred and eighty Eight by Joseph A. Russard and Susan C. Russard his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesses - that in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred and twenty five dollars, We the said Joseph A. Russard and Sarah C. Russard his wife do grant in fee simple unto Jonathan C. Main of said County and State all those pieces, parcels or parts of tracts of land with the premises thereon situate lying and being in Frederick County Maryland, on the Shookstown road about two miles North West of Frederick said to contain Eight and three Eighths acres of land more or less, and being the same property which the said Joseph A. Russard obtained from Elizabeth Main by Deed dated November the twenty second Eighteen hundred and eighty three and recorded in L. S. No. 7 folio 361 per one of the land records of Frederick County as by reference thereto will fully appear.
