No. 7548 Equity.

At the request of Jonathan C. Main the following Deed was recorded April 23rd 1875.

This deed made this 14th day of May A.D. 1874 by us Frederick Maser Jr. and Elizabeth Maser his wife of the one part and Jonathan C. Main of the other part all of Frederick County, Maryland, Witnesses, that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and thirty six Dollars & Eighty cents, the Frederick Maser Jr. and Elizabeth Maser his wife do grant unto Jonathan C. Main all that part of a tract of land called "Hawks Reserve" being part of the parcel of said tract which was about the year 1843 deeded by Joseph Fleming and others his et al of John Houch late of Frederick County, deceased to George Main for twenty one acres one rood & one perch, Beginning for the parcel hereby intended to be conveyed at the beginning of the whole tract of land called "Hawks Reserve" it also being the Beginning of George Main's part aforesaid and running thence with the line of the original tract three courses viz: South thirty two and a quarter degrees West, four ninety five one hundredth perch to a stone about 80 3/4" West twenty four perch to a stone about 85 3/4" West 16 1/10 perch to a stone at the end of the third line of George Main's parcel aforesaid, then with the fourth line of said parcel North 28 3/4" East fifty seven perches to a stake and pile of stone then South 70 1/2" East 32 7/10 perch to a stake and pile of stones in the closing line of the whole tract aforesaid and at the end of thirty five perch on said line measured from the beginning then with said closing line South 29 1/2 degrees West 35 perches to place of beginning containing more or less than rood and sixteen perch in fee simple.
