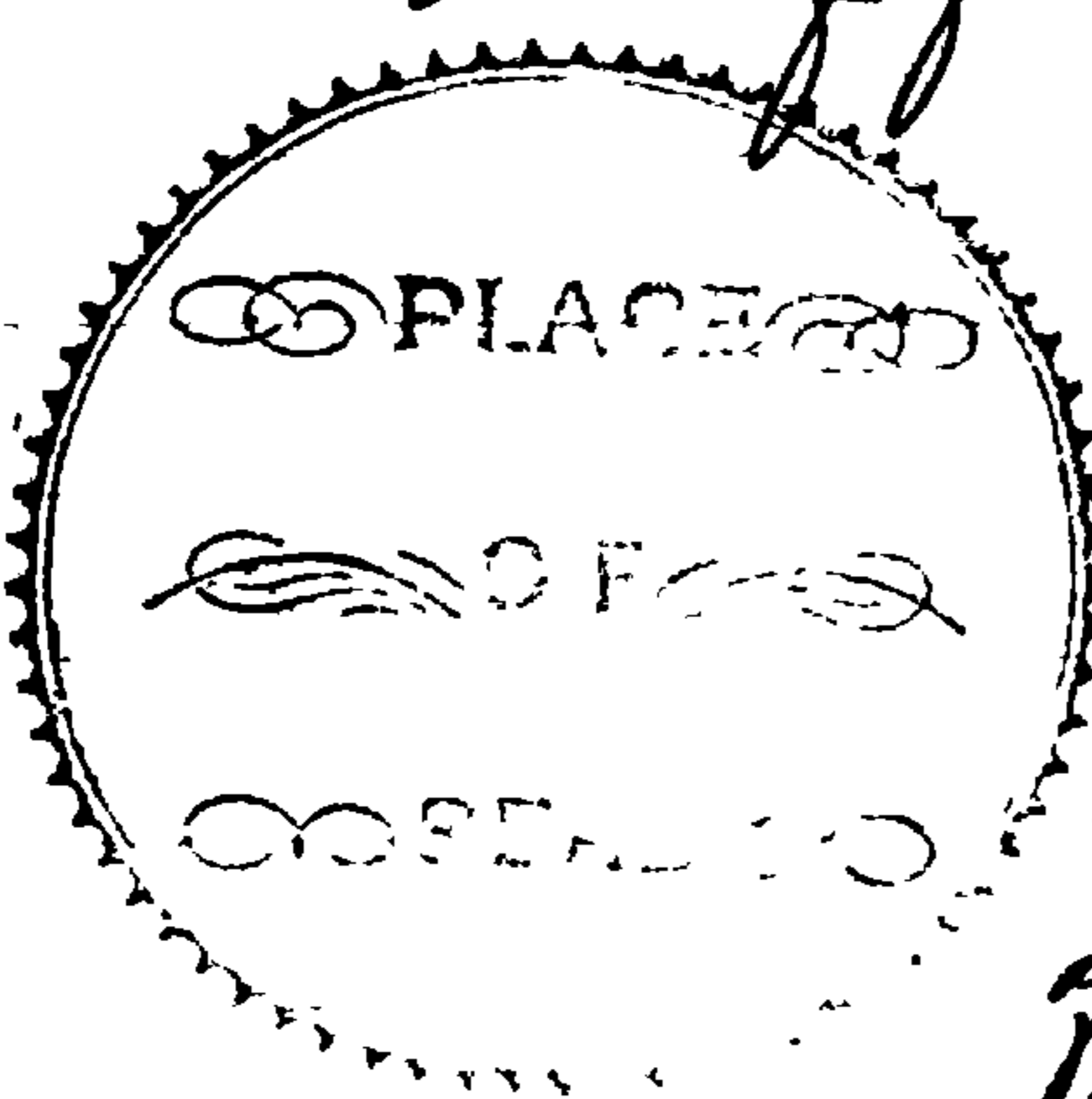

The object of the proceedings in this cause is to procure a decree for the sale of certain real estate of which Sarah A. Brown, did seized and possessed.
The Bill alleges that Sarah A. Brown departed this life in or about the month of July 1901 seized and possessed of a house and lot of ground situate on East Third Street in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland known as No. 81 East Third Street and being the same property conveyed to her by John Walter and wife by deed dated August 28th 1898, and recorded in Liber D. H. W. No. 2 folio 9 one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

That Sarah A. Brown by her last will did give and devise said property to her four children Theodore Clinton Brown Frances Emma Langer wife of John Langer) Nannie Louisa Brown and Florence Ida Brown for and during their lives vs. and did further provide that upon the death of all four of said children John Francis Smith Trustee should sell said property and divide the proceeds equally among the descendants of said children,
That John Francis Smith was appointed executor of said will duly qualified as such and in the settlement of said estate over paid the estate to the amount of forty five dollars and nine cents, (\$45.09)
