In pursuance of the annexed order of the court and notice given me by the Solicitors
for the Plaintiff in the above entitled cause, I Clayton O. Healy one of the regular Examiners
of said court duly appointed qualified and sworn having assigned the 30th day of
October A.D. 1902, at my office in Frederick City as the time and place for taking
the testimony in this cause and having given due notice thereof to the parties concerned
did at the appointed time and place proceed to take the following testimony to wit:-
The Plaintiff filed with the Examiner as evidence Exhibits Nos. 1, 2, & 3,
which are herewith returned by the said Examiner,

Nannie Louisa Brown a witness produced on the part of the Plaintiff being
duly sworn and examined viva voce deposes and says as follows:-

My name is Nannie Louisa Brown, my age is 27 years; I reside in Frederick
City. I know all the parties to this suit, I knew Sarah A. Brown in her life time.
She was my mother. - She is dead - She died in the month of July in the year
1901 - At the time of her death she owned a house and lot of ground on East
Third Street in Frederick City. The house is known as No. 81 East Third St.
which she purchased about 1898 from John Walter Exhibit No. 1 in this cause
to the Bill of Complaint correctly describes the said property. My mother
Sarah A. Brown left a last Will and Testament of which Exhibit No. 2
to said Bill is a copy John Francis Smith being executor and the estate
was settled by him which he overpaid to the extent of \$45.09 as appears
from his account a copy of which is filed as Exhibit No. 3 to said Bill. The
Personal Estate of my mother was insufficient for the payment of her debts.

Her son Clinton Theodore Brown and myself, Nannie Louisa Brown are
both above the age of 21 years; and reside in Frederick County, Md.

My sister, Florence Lee Brown also resides in Frederick County but is under
21 years of age and my sister Francis Emma Langer is more than 21 years
old but she does not reside in the State of Maryland. Her husband's name
is John Langer and they have one child living named John Langer
