To The Honorable, the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland,
sitting as a Court of Equity,

The Petition of Lena Cecilia Hildebrand, Katie May Hildebrand, Lucy M.
Schroeder, Blanche E. Hildebrand and Lewis H. Knock, and Infant and Charles
F. Knock, Junior, an infant by Charles F. Knock their father and next
friend, respectfully represents unto your Honors:--

1. That Lewis M. Hildebrand, late of Frederick County, Maryland, died in the year 1900
leaving a last will and testament dated June 8th in the year 1894 and which was
duly admitted to probate by the Orphan's Court for Frederick County, Maryland,
and recorded in Liber C. O. D. No. 1 folio 38 etc one of the records of wills in
the office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, State of Maryland as will appear by
reference to a duly certified copy of said last Will and Testament herewith filed as
a part hereof and marked "Exhibit A."

2. That Laura V. Hildebrand, the Executrix named in said last will and Testament
died on the date December 13th in the year nineteen hundred and two, and that
Annie E. Hildebrand, afterwards married unto Charles F. Knock and the sub-
stituted Executrix named in said last Will and Testament died in the year 1900.

3. That at the time of his death the said Lewis M. Hildebrand, the above named
Testator, was seized and possessed of a valuable lot of ground, improved with
a large dwelling house, situation lying and being on the North side of West Pat-
rick Street, in Frederick City, in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, and
being the same real estate as described in the deed from Thomas John M. Gill to
Lewis M. Hildebrand dated April 1st in the year 1872, and recorded in Liber C.
M. No. 8 folio 165 etc one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland,
a duly certified copy of which said deed is herewith filed as a part hereof and
marked "Exhibit B." and also a lot of ground as described in a Deed or certified
copy of which is herewith filed, marked "Exhibit C."

4. That as appears by the terms of said last will and Testament "Exhibit A." of
said Testator, the said Testator provides as follows:-- "I give, devise and be-
queath to my dear wife Laura V. Hildebrand the use of all my estate, - and
