(understanding, considering the certainty of death, and the certainty of the time thereof and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs) God, and my body to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executor hereinafter named, and after my debts and funeral charges are paid, I devise and bequeath as follows.

I give and devise unto Samuel and Matthias my two youngest sons my house and two lots and the appurtenances thereto belonging lying and being in Greengraston to them the said Samuel and Matthias and their heirs and assigns in fee simple.

I devise and bequeath all my personal property to be equally divided among my five children namely, Deborah, David, Lurannah, Samuel, and Matthias the said personal property to be sold by my executor hereinafter mentioned and the net proceeds thereof to be equally divided among my sons and daughters, as above mentioned.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint John R. Curtis to be sole Executor of this my last will and testament revoking and annulling all former Wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this, and none other to be my last Will and testament.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven.
