

Report of Sales

No. 7550 Equity.

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:-

Your Orator, Frank C. Norwood, the trustee appointed by your Honorable Court to make sale of the real estate decreed by your Honors to be sold, reporting sales by him made, says,
