Smith for \$50.00 and has been assigned to Edgar R. Young I knew the signature to these Exhibits to be that of Jonas F. Young.

5th Has Jonas F. Young seized & possessed of any real estate in this County at the time of his death, if yes describe the same.

Ans. He was, he owned 13 acres of land about 3 1/2 miles South West of Middletown which is correctly described in the deed filed in this cause at Exhibit D also eight acres of land, on South Mountain which is correctly described in the deed filed in this cause as Exhibit E. I should say that said land described in Exhibit - D. & E. is worth about \$1700.00
