The Bill of Complaint of Barbara E. Hinea, Mother and next friend of Terence M.
Infant, temporarily residing in Frederick County, State of Maryland, but actual res-
idents of the State of Ohio respectfully represent unto your Honors. -

First

That Calom L. Hinea late of Frederick County, State of Ohio died in or about
the month of August in the year A. D. 1892 leaving a last will and testament
which containing certain devises and bequests to his wife Barbara E. Hinea for and
during her natural life and after her death all of the real and personal property
to vest in his children as named in the said last will and testament, all of whom
well fully appear by a duly certified copy of which said will is filed in the
Office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County a certified copy of the same being
filed herewith as "Exhibit A." which together with all other exhibits herewith filed
it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill of Complaint

Second.
That the said Calom L. Hinea, was in his life time and at the time of his death
seized and possessed of a certain piece or parcel of land situated, lying and
being in Frederick County, State of Maryland consisting of about thirty five acres
three rods and twelve perches of land more or less, the said Calom L. Hinea having
obtained the by deed from David McCall and Mary McCall his wife, dated April 6th
A. D. 1872 which said deed is duly recorded in Liber A 7 No 4 folio 566, one of
the land records of Frederick County said deed being filed herewith as a part of this
Bill of Complaint marked Exhibit "B"

Third. That the said Calom L. Hinea, being seized as aforesaid left surviving him
as his heirs at law and devisees under his said last will and testament "Exhibit A."
